A Message From the Principal

A review of the current grading weight categories has led us to inform parents of the upcoming changes to take place beginning in the 2nd semester, January 2018. The current weight categories are as follows:

> Tests/Assessments = 30% Projects/Assignments = 20% Quizzes = 20% Benchmarks = 20% Homework/Class Participation = 10%

Beginning January 2018, the new grading weight categories will be as follows:

Daily Assignments/Homework = 40% Tests, Quizzes, Projects, Essays = 40% Benchmarks = 20%

The rationale for changing the grading weight categories is for grading practices to be more reflective of the instruction and students' work during the 9 weeks. The staff at MPMS believes the new weight categories will allow assignments to be more equally balanced in the average of the final grade for students.
