1ST SEMESTER GRADE REPAIR

MPMS will be offering grade repair for those students that failed courses during the first semester.

Registration for 1st semester grade repair will begin on January 8th. The deadline for registration will be on January 19th. Applications are available at the front office or on the school's website. Sessions will be held January 29th through March 8th on Monday through Thursday from 3:15 PM until 4:15 PM. *Transportation needs will be addressed as needed.*

In order to be eligible for grade repair, students must have earned a minimum score of 60 in the desired class for repair. The original failing grade can only be raised to a maximum of 70. To receive a 70, students must attend 5 or 10 contact hours and complete required lessons. Students earning a grade in the 60-64 average range will complete 10 contact hours. Students earning a grade in the 65-69 average range will complete 5 contact hours.

Discipline issues will not be tolerated! Students are expected to be on task at all times while present. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the student being denied opportunity to repair grade. All MacIntyre Park Middle School and Thomasville City Schools Board of Education policies will be enforced.

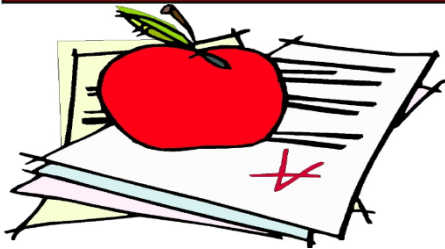
