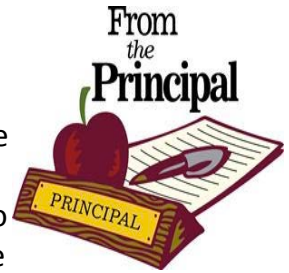

GEAR UP FOR GEORGIA MILESTONES

Parents can help their child prepare for the Georgia Milestones Assessment by taking advantage of some resources available online. The state of Georgia has a website that will allow students the opportunity to experience, firsthand, the functionality of the online Testing platform prior to the actual administration of the GMAS. The practice website is located at www.gaexperienceonline.com. The items on the demonstration tests are general and are organized into three grade bands: Grades 3 – 5, Grades 6 – 8, and High School, in the content areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. The items do not necessarily represent the specific grade-level content that students learn daily in their classrooms.



We encourage our parents/guardians to use this resource at home to provide additional practice for our students with the online platform. No login is required. To access a test, just click on the login button.

The website is best accessed using the Chrome web browser. Technical documentation, tutorials, and a link to your online experience can also be found on the website. We hope you find the *Experience Online Testing Georgia* website helpful as we enter the Spring testing season. *Please note the sample tests are not graded, so have fun!*
